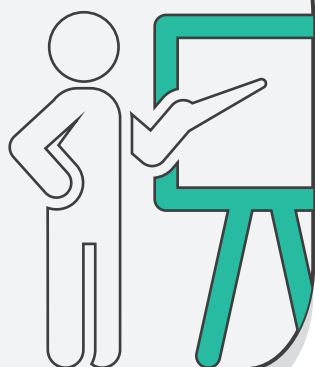


THINKING ABOUT A CAREER IN LANGUAGE?

Impart your skills

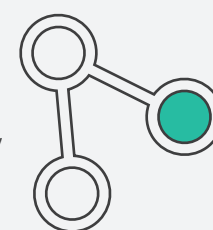
Working in a range of different industries, a translator/interpreter converts written and spoken information from one language to another, ensuring the original meaning stays the same.
