Task 6: Vehicle Survey

Depending on the **time** of the **year** (and the **weather** conditions), there should be plenty of **visitors/tourists** around the village of **Leysin**. In order to try to gauge the **extent** of the **tourist/resort function** of **Leysin**, a **car/car park survey** can be quite revealing. The results can show the **sphere of influence** of **Leysin** i.e. the distances **visitors/tourists** travel to visit **Leysin**.

- (a) Your teacher(s) will **brief** you about **what** exactly it is that you have to do and **where** about the tasks should be done. Each group may be given a different area of Leysin to survey.
- (b) Always **seek permission** from the **car park attendant** if there is one on duty. An "introductory note" is given below to show to the "**gardien de parking**" should this be necessary:-
