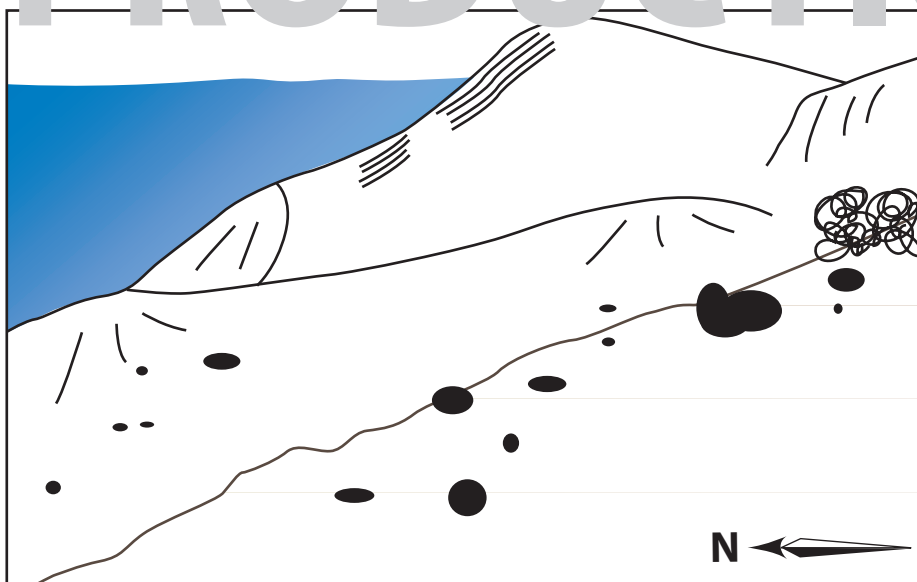


(b) Now look around you from where you are standing; then complete the box below:-
