# Normandy

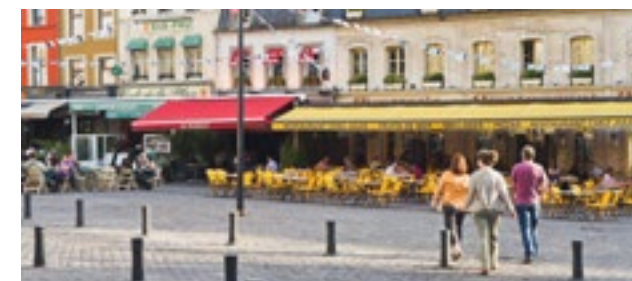

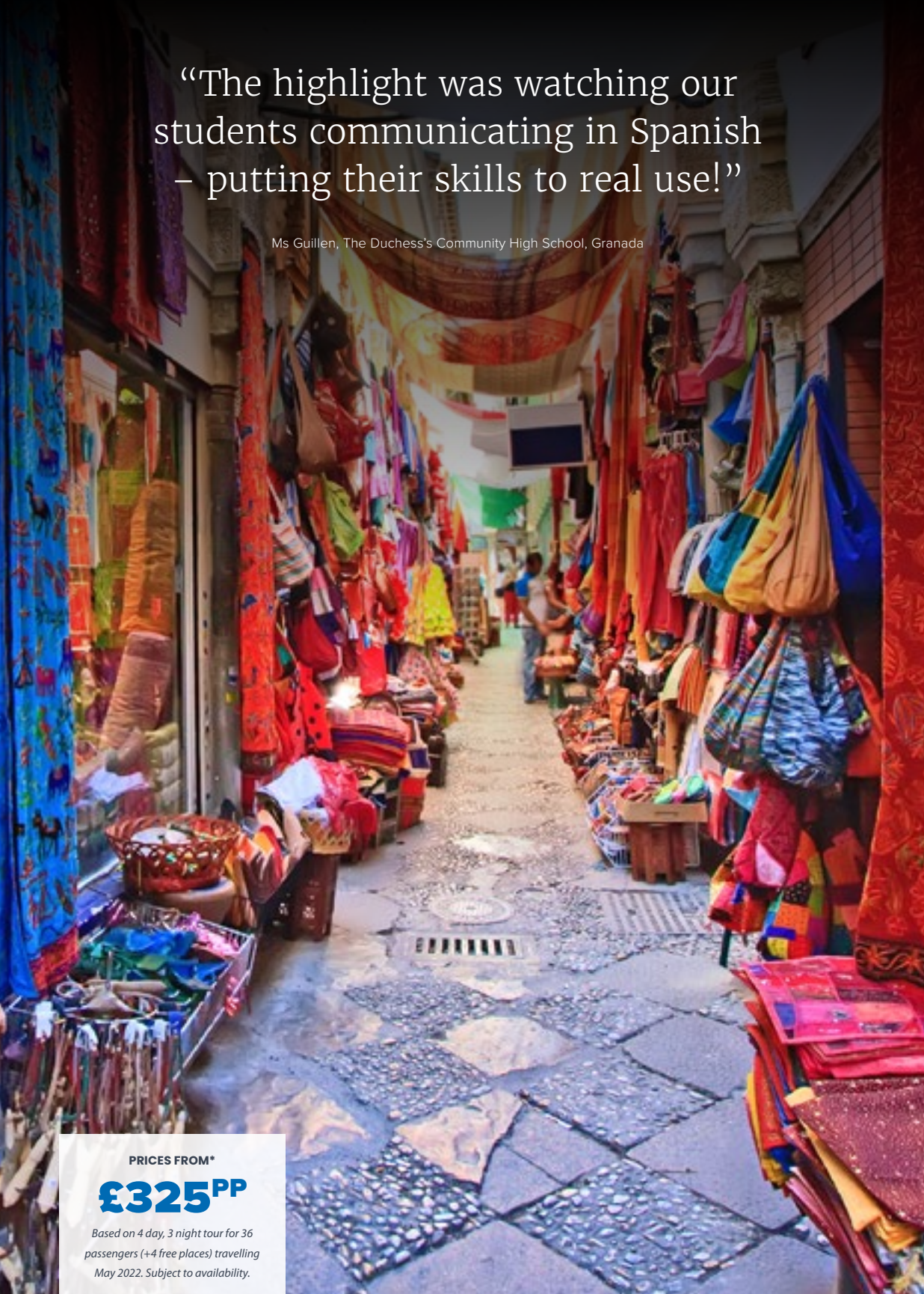

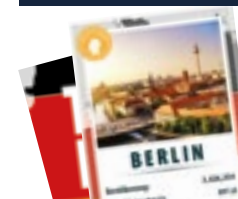
